

Thanksgiving and Remembrance

In the months of October and November special days of thanksgiving and remembrance are observed around the country.

Churches and chapels have Thanksgiving Services to thank God for the harvest. At the chapel we are holding our Harvest Thanksgiving service on 5th October where we will give thanks to God and remember His provision.

Many around the world cannot go to the local supermarket to buy their food and are dependant on a good harvest where they live to eat and provide for their families.

We have supported 'Operation Agri - Christian Love in Action' for many years and our Harvest Offering will be for their 2025 appeal: 'Trees Bees and Seeds'.

It is supporting the **Imarika** project in Tanzania with partner Emmanuel International which helps village churches to bring their community together to save money, and restore their environment. They learn to grow and plant trees, and to improve the soil for better crops. They can also learn bee-keeping and other ways to earn money and lift families out of poverty.

In the Bible Leviticus 19:9 says 'When you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not reap your field right up to its edge, neither shall you gather the gleanings after your harvest.' This was God's provision for those in society less well off than most who could collect the remaining harvest. We can follow this by donating one or two items from our weekly harvest to local food banks, volunteering to help at a food bank to distribute the gleanings of the harvest, or donating to projects such as Operation Agri.

We should always be thankful, and remember, that food from a field grown in Tanzania by the community, purchased from a shop in England, or received from a food bank is an outworking of God's provision.

The 9th of November is Remembrance Sunday. Communities throughout the country come together on this day around memorials which were erected in remembrance and thanksgiving for those who left their homes to serve their country in wars and who paid the ultimate sacrifice for our freedom. At Perry we especially remember the five men whose names are engraved on the village war memorial situated on the chapel wall.

May God bless you during this time of Thanksgiving and Remembrance.
