Gateways and Guides

We have eaten the Easter eggs, and found all the birds on the village trail. The lovely daffodils have gone and even the Chiltern Green bluebells have faded. Yes the Spring season has gone and the Summer season with exciting holidays is nearly here.

BUT, for our young people it is EXAM season.

For many in our village and in our families it is SATS, GCSEs, A levels or Uni finals or 'just' the end of year exams. As someone who spent a lifetime in education I have to say they are important. The qualifications and skills they achieve are 'gateways' for the future.

In the Gospel of John we find the 'I am' sayings of Jesus.

Perhaps the strangest is 'I am the gate'. (John 10:9) This is part of the chapter where Jesus says, 'I am the Good Shepherd'.

As it is today, herds of sheep with their shepherds were familiar sights in New Testament times. The Lord Jesus used the illustration of the caring shepherd to show his love and care for us His sheep.

The shepherd would bring the sheep into the fold at night. These enclosures had an open entrance, but no gate. Once all of the sheep were safely in the shepherd would lie across the entrance. He would be 'the gate'. He was their protection in those dark hours. No wild animal or human thief could get in and attack the sheep.

Jesus developed the illustration saying that the Good Shepherd led the sheep out to find pasture. Not just a 'gate' but a 'gateway'.

The Good Shepherd cared for the sheep in every way. Including, as we remember in another parable, searching desperately for the one 'lost sheep'

Psalm 23 'The Lord's my Shepherd' is many people's favourite. And I'm sure we will be singing it at our Summer Songs of Praise.

There are some reassuring promises in that Psalm for us and our young people.

'The Lord is my shepherd I lack nothing'

'He leads me beside quiet waters'

'He guides me along the right paths'

'Surely your goodness and love will follow me'

Read or sing the Psalm again and find some more.

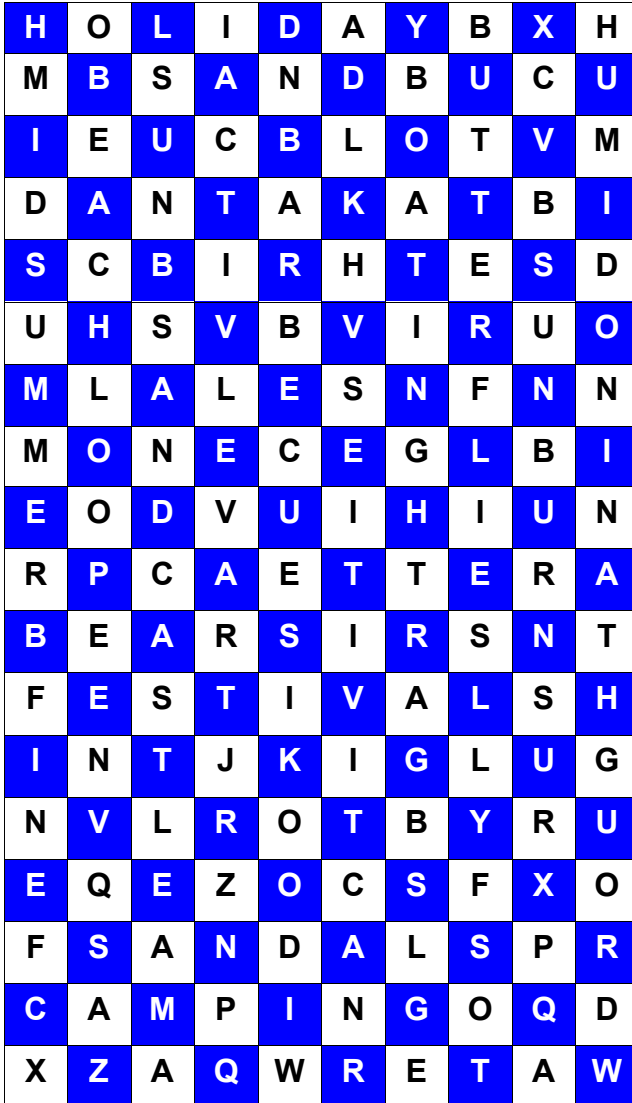
